The 'anchor' defines a foundation from which to collect data on planning and building clean waterfronts. Quality control information is developed on specific water-body sites and product applications.

Reviews are conducted by independent, inter-disciplinary alliances who are guided by industry best management practices (BMPs) and best applied technologies (BATs).

Specific review seals contain a location number (zip code) and the year of the last review.
